

ALKEMIE: ETHICS AND MALPRACTICE STATEMENT

REVIEWING PROCEDURES

All papers are subject to a double-blind peer review process. The papers are evaluated by two reviewers. In case their decisions are completely opposed, a third reviewer will evaluate the paper. Reviews must be signed and submitted to the editorial board. The name of reviewers is not disclosed to the authors.

The authors should send two copies of their articles: one that is signed and one that is not signed. Authors are solely responsible for the authenticity of the submitted articles. In case the reviewers consider the articles to be plagiarized, the articles are rejected.

Reviewers are asked to fill in the review form and send a signed copy to the editorial board.

POLICY OF SCREENING FOR PLAGIARISM

We discourage every form of plagiarism. The authors should ensure that their works are original and have not been published elsewhere. The legal responsibility for plagiarism rests exclusively with the authors. Papers submitted to Alkemie Journal will be screened for plagiarism and authors will be required to revise their article if the reviewers decide there is a suspicion of plagiarism. However, articles may be rejected if the reviewers consider that is the case.

Alkemie Journal aims to protect the rights of authors and investigates any claims of plagiarism or misuse of articles even after publication. In case plagiarism is detected after publication, an investigation may be conducted and an explanation written by the editors will be placed in the next issues of the journal. The author(s) are obliged to provide retractions or corrections of mistakes and should provide a list of references and any financial support. The publishers and editors will publish any corrections, clarifications, retractions and apologies if the authors require such a procedure.

COPYRIGHT POLICY

Exclusive responsibility of the articles is retained by the authors. The editors and proofreaders of Alkemie Journal will not be held liable for copyright infringement.

The author grants the Classiques Garnier Publishing House unlimited rights to publish the articles. When the articles are selected for publication, the authors must sign an agreement with Maison d'Édition des Classiques Garnier, and respect the editorial policy of the journal, which reserves the right to any legal remedy in case of non-compliance. The corresponding authors will be required to sign and submit an Author Agreement Form that will be sent to them after the work has been accepted for publication.
